## DMV Fees as of July 1st, 2016

State driver license offices accept the following forms of payment:

- Cash
- Check (made payable to DOR)
- Credit Card: Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover Card

If you are 21 years of age or older and your driver license is lost, stolen or mutilated, you will be required to purchase a regular driver license per Colorado Revised Statute 42-2-117 (1.5).
