

PROOF OF ADDRESS

REQUIREMENT

CHANGES

Beginning August 19, 2015

two proof of Colorado residential address
will be required for the following applicants:

- New Applicants
- Individuals with expired Colorado license/permit/ID over 1 year
- Individuals changing their address
- Individuals reinstating their license that require testing

Individuals with a **valid – or expired less than one year – Colorado driver license, instruction permit or identification** card displaying their current physical address can present only that document.

All documents must include the customer's name, full residential address and be dated within one year or less.

Electronic documents are not acceptable.
