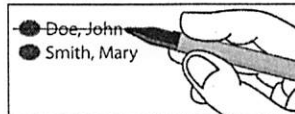
INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:

Making selections



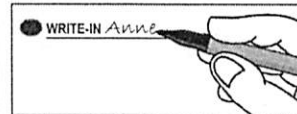
To vote for a candidate whose name appears on the ballot, FILL IN THE OVAL to the left of your choice using blue/black ink.

Making Corrections



If you make an error on your selection, make a strikethrough across the oval and name or answer indicating your intent NOT to vote for that selection.

Optional Write-in



To vote for a qualified write-in candidate, write the person's name in the blank space provided and FILL IN THE OVAL to the left.

WARNING: Any person who, by use of force or other means, unduly influences an eligible elector to vote in any particular manner or to refrain from voting, or who falsely makes, alters, forges or counterfeits any mail ballot before or after it has been cast, or who destroys, defaces, mutilates, or tampers with a ballot is subject, upon conviction, to imprisonment, or to a fine, or both. Section 1-7.5-107(3)(b), C.R.S.

Ballot Measures

Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A "yes/for" vote on any ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on any ballot question is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances.

State Measures

Proposition CC (STATUTORY)

WITHOUT RAISING TAXES AND TO BETTER FUND PUBLIC SCHOOLS, HIGHER EDUCATION, AND ROADS, BRIDGES, AND TRANSIT, WITHIN A BALANCED BUDGET, MAY THE STATE KEEP AND SPEND ALL THE REVENUE IT ANNUALLY COLLECTS AFTER JUNE 30, 2019, BUT IS NOT CURRENTLY ALLOWED TO KEEP AND SPEND UNDER COLORADO LAW, WITH AN ANNUAL INDEPENDENT AUDIT TO SHOW HOW THE RETAINED REVENUES ARE SPENT?

Springfield Cemetery District Ballot Issue 6A Mill Levy Increase

SHALL THE SPRINGFIELD CEMETERY DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED BY AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$96,210.00 ANNUALLY IN THE FIRST FULL YEAR (2019 TAXES PAYABLE IN 2020), AND BY WHATEVER ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS ARE RAISED ANNUALLY THEREAFTER BY A MILL LEVY INCREASE AT A RATE OF 2.00 MILLS OVER AND ABOVE THE EXISTING MILL LEVY RATE OF 1.124 FOR A TOTAL MILL LEVY OF 3.124 MILLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE DISTRICT'S ADMINISTRATION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE EXPENSES; AND SHALL THE DISTRICT BE AUTHORIZED TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND SPEND THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH TAXES AND ALL OTHER AMOUNTS RECEIVED ANNUALLY FROM ANY REVENUE SOURCES WHATSOEVER AS A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE WITHOUT REGARD TO ANY SPENDING, REVENUE-RAISING OR OTHER LIMITATION CONTAINED WITHIN ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION, SECTION 29-1-301, C.R.S., OR ANY OTHER LAW?
