

COVID-19 5 Star Qualification Baca County (Orange)

This report was created on January 21, 2021.

ELIGIBILITY

In order for a county to open 5 star businesses at a less restrictive level, a county must have:


- A two-week incidence in the appropriate dial level (Orange: lower than 350, Yellow: lower than 175, Blue: lower than 75 per 100,000) for all of the past 7 days
- A two-week percent positivity in the appropriate dial level (Orange: 15% or lower, Yellow: 10% or lower, Blue: 5% or lower) for all of the past 7 days
- Under 90% of regional ICU beds in use, and days of stable or declining hospitalizations in the past two weeks in the appropriate dial level (Orange: 7 or fewer days, Yellow: 8 or more days, Blue: 12 or more days).


INCIDENCE

Baca county's two-week cumulative incidence rate from Jan. 7 through Jan. 20 is 1,490.4 per 100,000. 0 days out of the last 7 are below 350 per 100,000. (Fail)

PERCENT POSITIVITY

Baca county's two-week positivity from Jan. 7 through Jan. 20 is 5.3%. 7 days out of the last 7 are 15% or lower. (Pass)





HOSPITALIZATIONS

25% of ICU beds in the Southeast region are currently in use. (Pass) There have been no more than two new hospitalizations per day of Baca county residents reported in the past two weeks. (Pass)
