

# Get Your COVID-19 Vaccine



On June 25, 2021 Baca County Public Health Agency along with Southeast Colorado Hospital District and the Baca County Board of Public Health will be hosting a COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic! For the health and safety of our communities and families as well as individuals we encourage you to come and be vaccinated and help prevent the spread of COVID-19!

The state of Colorado has opened the vaccination up for all Coloradans 12 and older to receive Pfizer; however for the Moderna vaccine you must be the age of 18 or older. There is a Vaccination Screening form that will need to be completed. NOTE: The health assessment section on the form must be completed after you arrive at the vaccine clinic.
