In need of a little help with chores?

If you or someone you know is 60 years of age or older and in need of help with chores services, contact Baca County Public Health Agency today! Through a grant provided by the Lower Arkansas Valley Area Agency on Aging (LAVAAA), Baca County Public Health Agency can reimburse eligible participants for up to 4 hours of work per month. Note: Hours may change as funding is available. The program offers great flexibility, as older adults are able to choose who completes the chores based on their schedule. Older adults can be reimbursed for a variety of services they have completed be the person of their choosing.

Chores that can be reimbursed on: *Note this is not the complete chores service list.*

- **Cleaning appliances, carpets, rugs, floors, windows, attics, basements, porches, or outbuildings.**
- **Moving or rearranging furniture, turning mattresses, replacing batteries on smoke and/or carbon monoxide detectors.**
- **Yardwork and walkway clearing.**
- **Installing or removing screens, storm doors, or windows.**
- **Cleaning exterior surfaces and removing mildew from siding or decking.**
